Welcome to the January Edition of Samvaad. This edition highlights the contribution of Tech Mahindra SMART Academy for Logistics in building a skilled workforce for the logistics sector. Starting in 2018 from Visakhapatnam, the Academy has now expanded to Chennai, Hyderabad and Bhubaneswar, strategically responding to the coastline requirements for skilled logistics professionals.

Nearly 22 million people are employed in India's logistics sector, which includes e-commerce delivery to warehouse and cargo management. But, only 4.7% of those engaged are formally skilled. Tipped to be one of the top five employment generators in the country, this huge skilling gap has also added to the cost burden of the industry.

Tech Mahindra SMART Academy for Logistics took the leap in Logistics & Supply Chain Management training and is working with partners like GIZ, JSW Foundation, Odisha Skill Development Authority to prepare well-trained youth to address this sector's skilling gaps. Innovative curriculum, technological interventions, scholarships, and outreach programs in the Logistics Academies have helped bring youth from diverse backgrounds under the ambit of the program.

Bringing Change with Logistics Academies



TMF's Logistics Academies cover a broad spectrum of logistics-related topics to cater to various job requirements within the industry. In addition to technical skills, the Academies offer training in soft skills such as communication, teamwork, and problem-solving. Focusing on practical, hands-on training, the curriculum integrates Augmented Reality/Virtual Reality (AR/VR) and Metaverse-based learning for engaging and interactive experiences. Trainees can virtually practice tasks such as operating forklifts and managing inventory in a safe environment.



Prioritising Inclusion

The logistics sector has historically seen less participation from women. Logistics Academies are working to create a level playing field for everyone with extensive outreach, awareness, and scholarship initiatives. This year, there has been a positive change, with more than 30% of admissions coming from women students.

TMF is actively working to support more young people from Marine Fishers' communities near the Academies with skilling opportunities and scholarships up to 80% of Academy fees. Students from other disadvantaged backgrounds continue to receive up to 50% scholarships.



Moving Ahead with Partnerships

Over the years TMF has joined hands with both government and private organisations on various fronts. The ASCENT program, in collaboration with GIZ, has been instrumental in training trainers with improved pedagogy and technical skills, incorporating AR/VR and self-paced learning content. TMF's partnership with JSW Foundation has been able to support many students in the Academies. The Foundation has been recognised as an affiliated training partner of the Logistics Sector Skill Council. The Academy has also partnered with BIBS, a Kolkata-based Management Institute for their MBA course in Supply Chain Management. In collaboration with Odisha Skill Development Authority (OSDA), TMF's Logistics Academy in Bhubaneswar is now making skilling in logistics accessible for the youth of the state.


